Raysville Campground is located on Georgia's Little River section of J. Strom Thurmond Lake, the largest Corps of Engineers Lake east of the Mississippi River. It contains 55 sites, each with water hook-ups and 50-amp electric service. A boat ramp for campers provides access to the 70,000 acre Thurmond Lake. A dump station and two shower/restroom facilities are located within the campground.

Please Observe:

- To help make everyone's stay a pleasant an enjoyable one, we ask that you observe the following camping rules.
- · Check in time is 3:00 p.m.; checkout is 2:00 p.m.
- Maximum campsite occupancy: One (1) wheeled unit per site, tents limited to impact pad capacity, four (4) passenger vehicles and 12 people.
- All vehicles, RVs, and trailers must be parked on your campsite or driveway, not in the woods or on the grass. Tents must be set up on the campsite.
- Quite hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Gates are closed and locked at 10:00 p.m and reopen at 7:00 a.m.
- All pets must be penned or on a leash no longer than six (6) feet.
 Owners must clean up after their pets.
- Dead and down wood may be used for firewood, but please do not cut any standing trees or brush.
- Campfires must be confined to the fire rings provided at each site.
- Keep your campsite clean. Trash dumpsters are provided at a central location in the park.
- Dispose of wastewater and sewage at the sanitary dump station.
- · Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Discharging firearms or fireworks in the campground is prohibited.
- · Visitor hours end at 9:30 p.m.
- ATV's are prohibited. Golf carts are allowed.
- Registered occupant of campsite must be at least 18 yrs old.
