

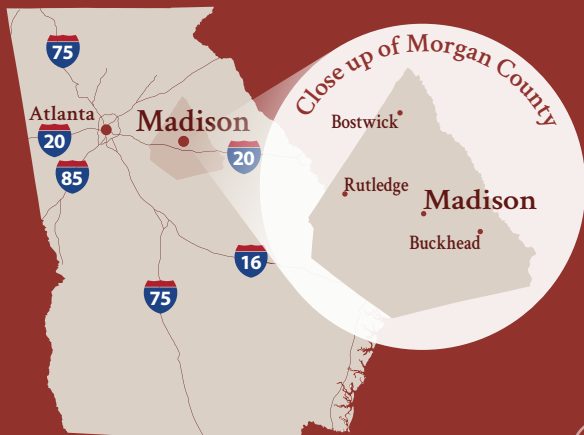

MUSEUMS & TOURS

Once described in the 1845 Guide to Georgia as the “most cultured and aristocratic town on the stagecoach route from Charlestown to New Orleans,” Madison’s immaculately preserved historic buildings and distinctive museums offer a peek into the town’s history and heritage. Start your exploration into the town’s unique story with a free, self-guided walking tour of the Madison Historic District and make sure to take time to visit the museums you pass along the way.



Heritage Hall

Heritage Hall is one of the finest of Madison's antebellum homes. Open Tuesday - Sunday for guided tours. (\$10, or \$15 for Combination Ticket including Rogers House and Rose Cottage)

Rogers House

Built in the Piedmont Plain style in 1809, this is one of Madison's oldest homes. Included with Heritage Hall Combination Ticket (\$15)

Rose Cottage

Born to enslaved parents, Adeline Rose built this home in 1891 for \$100. Included with Heritage Hall Combination Ticket (\$15)

Madison-Morgan Cultural Center

Built in 1895, this Romanesque Revival building served as one of the first graded public schools in the South. Today the museum displays an original classroom, art galleries and fascinating artifacts from Madison's past. Open Tuesday - Saturday. (\$5 Adults, \$4 Seniors, \$3 Students w/ ID)

MADISON-MORGAN CULTURAL CENTER

Celebrating History and the Arts

The **Madison-Morgan Cultural Center** is a non-profit multidisciplinary history, performance, and visual arts center. The Center occupies an elegantly restored 1895 Romanesque Revival building in the heart of Madison's National Register Historic District that used to house one of the first graded public schools in the Southeast. For over 40 years, the Center has presented big-name entertainment in the historic setting of its renovated 1895 school auditorium.

Piedmont History Museum



Inside its walls, the Center hosts several permanent collections including a history exhibition highlighting the Piedmont region of GA in the 19th Century and a restored 1895 Schoolroom.

Live & Virtual Performances



The Center has used its Auditorium to build a reputation for excellence in performing arts through the presentation of theatre, dance, music, lectures, and other programs featuring regional, national and international talent.

Art Galleries



The Center houses three art galleries with three to four rotating exhibitions a year. The exhibitions feature all mediums, including ceramics, photography, and mixed media.

48 HOURS *in Madison*

DAY 1

Morning Begin your day at **Farmview Market**, a farmers market and café dedicated to the farm-to-table movement. Check out the butcher shop, grist mill and fresh produce before you hunker down for a breakfast that is sure to fuel your day.

After the market, it's time to tour some of Madison's favorite museums. Appreciate history and the arts at the **Madison-Morgan Cultural Center** or the **Morgan County African-American Museum**, or trace the steps of Madison's former residents by touring one of Madison's four historic house museums. Can't choose just one? Get a combination ticket to visit **Heritage Hall**, **Rogers House** and **Rose Cottage**.

Afternoon Enjoy a delicious lunch at one of Madison's unique restaurants. Some local favorites include **Dolce Caffè**, **Mad Taco**, **Amici Pizza & Brewery** and **The Madison Produce Co.**

Prepare to discover downtown with a stop at the **Welcome Center**. Here you can get started on the self-guided walking tour and make a game plan for exploring the **Madison Historic District**. You'll find unique boutiques, eateries, antiques and home décor stores galore, all within easy walking distance!

Evening Wind down and refuel at one of Madison's exceptional restaurants. After dinner, catch a performance at the **Madison-Morgan Cultural Center** or take a sunset stroll through **Town Park**.

DAY 2

Take time to wander beautiful Morgan County. Just minutes outside of Madison, you can explore Georgia's second-largest state park **Hard Labor Creek State Park** and the "small but special" **City of Rutledge**, go horseback riding at an authentic dude ranch at **Southern Cross Guest Ranch**, or even find your peace with a holistic, therapeutic treatment at **ZEN Relaxing Wellness Center**.

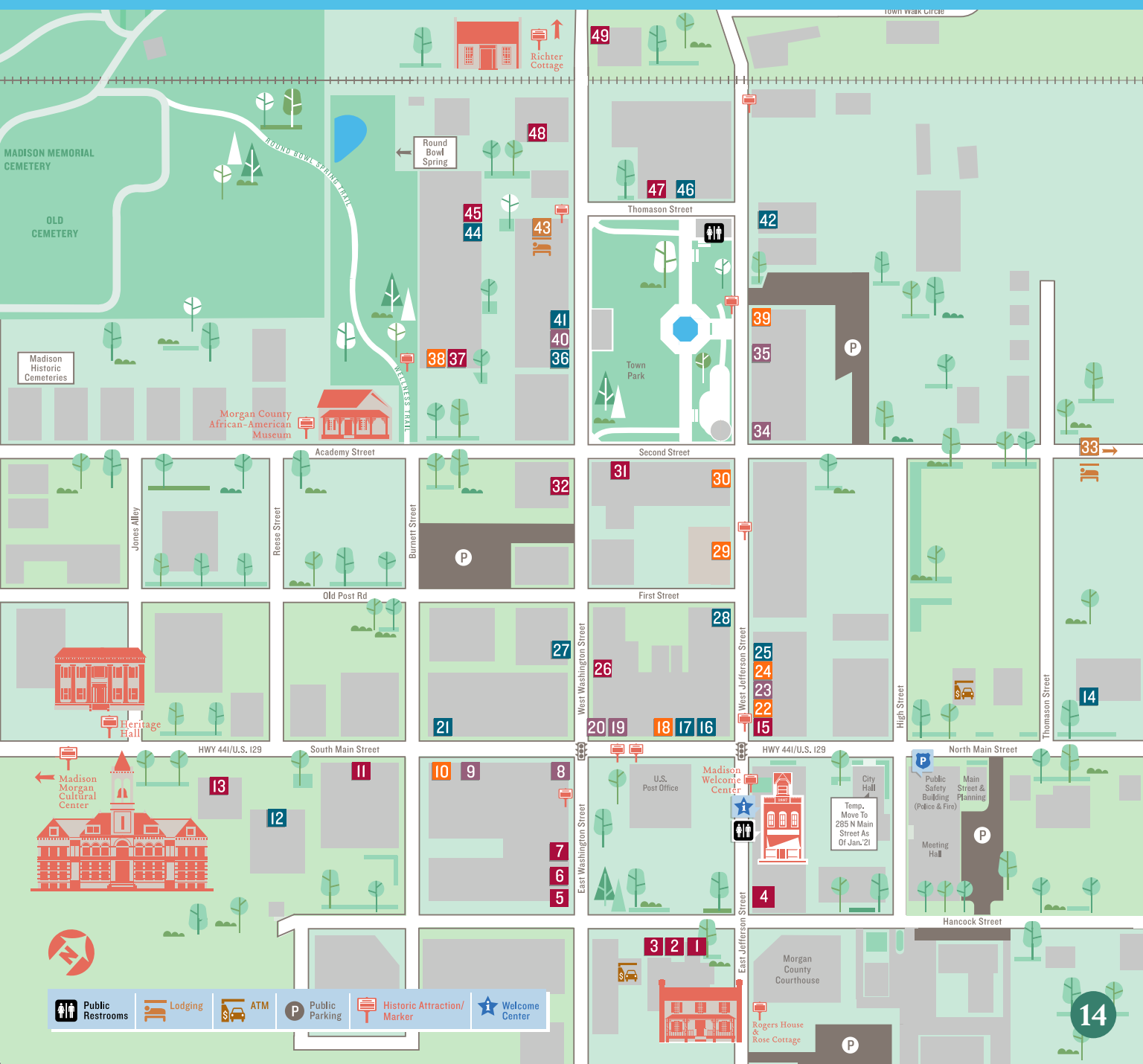



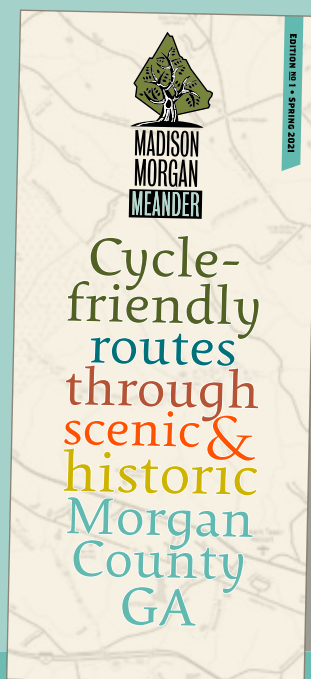

The Town of Buckhead

Not to be confused with Atlanta's bustling Buckhead, our Buckhead is known as the REAL Buckhead! Making up the western banks of beautiful Lake Oconee, this town (population 187) is home to Blue Springs Marina, Sugar Creek Marina and the exceptional Steffen Thomas Museum of Art. Settled in the early 1800s, Buckhead was incorporated in 1908. But its heyday came in the 1930s when the Georgia Railroad designated it as a layover between Atlanta and Augusta.

The City of Rutledge

Just west of Madison lies Rutledge, a town of only 800 and the gateway to Hard Labor Creek State Park. Rutledge's historic district is virtually unchanged since its heyday as a railroad town, founded in 1871. Here you can grab lunch at a deli housed in the last caboose to travel the Rutledge rails, pick up flower seeds at a hardware store in continuous operation since 1891, or maybe just catch up with an old friend over a piece of buttermilk pie at Yesterday's Cafe. With a popular farmer's market, summer concert series and other fun seasonal events – Rutledge may be small, but it sure is special!



📍 Bostwick Cotton Gin Festival

The City of Bostwick

In the 1920s, when cotton was king, Bostwick too was a booming town. It contained several cotton gins, a cotton seed mill, masonry, depot, train station and more. Today, Bostwick maintains one of the few operational cotton gins in Georgia.

Each year in November, the town celebrates its agrarian roots with the Cotton Gin Festival to support the restoration of the Susie Agnes Hotel, which now serves as the town's city hall. Many may recognize this red brick building from its film debut as Parker Hotel in the 1992 comedy *My Cousin Vinny*.
