



Chehaw Wild Animal Park was originally designed by Jim Fowler, a native of Albany, Ga., and host of Wild Kingdom. His attention to spacious exhibits offers extraordinary room for the animals that call Chehaw home.

The Wild Animal Park boasts over 212 specimens, representing 55 species of wild animals. Exhibits include African black rhino, American bald eagle, lemurs, meerkats, zebras, cheetahs and many more. Enjoy all of the exhibits Chehaw has to offer as you stroll through the scenic boardwalks and cypress swamp.

Also make sure to hang around for the alligator feedings and cheetah runs. These events allow you to see the animals close-up and view how they react in their natural environment.

With over 800 acres of pristine, conservation land and a wild animal park dedicated to education, Chehaw is a unique attraction for South Georgia. Being one of only two accredited zoos in Georgia, aside from Zoo Atlanta, Chehaw continues to be devoted to the three areas it was founded on; conservation, preservation and education.

From the Wild Animal Park to the endless recreational opportunities, Chehaw has an activity for every visitor. Come see what nature's playground has to offer you.

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Chehaw's campgrounds have 44 RV sites with 30 & 50 amp hookups, 14 pull-through sites, a comfort station with laundry, dump station and a group shelter. There are 18 tent sites with 15 amp electric and water. Camper cabins are available with A/C. All camp sites have a picnic table and fire ring with flip-top grill. Please call for reservations.



BMX

If you are searching for a safe, family-oriented BMX racing track, you can find it at Chehaw. The Friends of Chehaw Conservation Society and the National Bicycle League worked together to build this racing site for motocross enthusiast. The public can ride anytime with a bike and helmet. PARK PROGRAMS

If you are planning a trip to Chehaw, make the park's educational programs one of your activities. These programs are 30-minute sessions in the Hoots and Scutes Amphitheater and include a live animal showcase with accommodations for up to 100 participants. MUCKIN' AROUND THE MUCKALEE

DISC GOLF

Included in your park admission is access to the Joshua W. Franklin Memorial Disc Golf Course. Discs are available for sale or you can bring your own. Come enjoy this new sport that combines the rules of golf with the skills of frisbee.

PLAY PARK

Also, included in your park admission is access to our play park, which is one of the largest play areas for children in Southwest Georgia. Children can swing, climb, slide and play for hours while parents can take a break and watch from our picnic area next to the play park.

Chehaw's Wild Trail is perfect for serious runners or just for a relaxing stroll. This one-mile, looped trail takes visitors on a tour through some of the most scenic areas of the park. The crushed granite material on the trail makes for a comfortable walk, jog or run.

WIREGRASS EXPRESS

This scenic tour of the park takes its passengers on a 20-minute adventure through the park's native, towering pines and the wiregrass restoration area. The train runs March through December, and tickets can be purchased for riders over two years of age at the Wild Animal Park Gift Shop
