

A Historic and Educational Destination

Laura Pope Forester (1873-1953), the woman who shaped the Popes Museum, is a nationally significant American self-taught artist. Her artwork onsite includes a fifteen-foot high, one hundred-foot long entry gate decorated with intricate lacework fashioned from cast iron sewing machine legs, as well as a multitude of large busts including those of Generals Eisenhower and MacArthur, British and American nurses of the Second World War, and Georgia educator Martha Berry. An imposing monument to the Red Cross nurses of the First World War also remains onsite. Laura's mural "Four Planes in a Golden Sky" was recently donated and returned to Popes Museum. The historic gardens include heirloom camellias, roses, magnolias, 25- foot tall crepe myrtle and magnificently aged cedar trees.
