

It's a great place for bird-watching and wildlife photography.

The 60-acre oasis of woodlands and massive oaks is the dream-cometrue of Harvin Carter, who built this equine facility for his daughter, Ashley, and their horses. But it's more than a place where horselovers and nature-lovers can gather; it's also a beautifully serene place for groups to celebrate birthdays, reunions, and nuptials.



Kids of all ages will enjoy wiggling a line in the stocked fishing pond. Explore Newell Lodge's beautiful surroundings by horseback or by golf cart. Hike through the woods, or enjoy a fun outdoor





With 26 healthy horses to choose from, each rider at Newell Lodge is matched with a horse whose size and temperament is suitable for those even as young as age six. From sunrise to sunset, trail rides and lessons will keep visitors improving their "saddle skills." Games and other activities are offered in conjunction with the equine and educational learning experience, as well.

Newell Lodge's owners have shared their love of and respect for horses with their many visitors since opening in 2007. They teach visitors how to ride, care for, house, and

Quail & WILD GAME HUNTING

Georgia's famous quail hunting tradition is inextricably tied to its rich plantation history. The numerous cotton plantations established in the rich soil around Folkston in the 1850s continued to operate as winter retreats for wealthy Northerners after the agricultural collapse of the late 1870s.

These winter retreats preserved large tracts of prime quail habitat for generations. However, the longleaf pine-wiregrass ecosystem that the bob-white calls home has disappeared or become fragmented throughout much of the majestic game bird's range. The property owned by Newell Lodge harbors some of the last remaining stands of longleaf pine in the Southeast.

Currently, Newell Lodge has plans to develop an area of prime quail and



wild game habitat to preserve this fine Southern tradition. Expected to begin in 2011, the Newell Lodge shooting preserve will allow sportsmen to appreciate world-class hunting and the rich culture of plantation life. Visit NewellResort.com.
