
AndrewServes

Required Admission Materials

- \$20 application fee
- Official high school transcripts
- Official copies of SAT and/or ACT scores

Admission Categories *Unconditional Admission*

Minimum 2.0 high school GPA

SAT: 1000 Composite

500 Evidenced-Based Reading and Writing, 500 Math

ACT: 19 ACT Composite

19 ACT English, 19 ACT Math

Conditional Admission

- Minimum 2.0 high school GPA
- SAT or ACT scores falling below the minimum required for unconditional admission

Provisional Admission

Students who fall below the criteria for unconditional or conditional admission will be evaluated by the Enrollment Management Committee and will be required to participate in either an in-person or a telephone interview.

Articulation Agreements




