When we say It's All Happening ...In The Grove,

- In the spring, the grounds of the old Locust
 Grove Institute, now City Hall, come alive
 with our annual Easter Egg Hunt, parade and
 bonnet contest.
- Spring also brings our annual Locust Grove
 Day, usually held in April. Complete with
 parade, arts and crafts, food, games, and
 entertainment, it is a full day of fun for the
 entire family.
- Enjoy dining and dancing under the stars in May at Groovin' in the Grove. May is also home to the annual Peach Stand Road Race, a 5K that begins and ends at the historic Gardner Farms Peach Stand.
- During the Summer, bring your lawn chairs and picnics on the second and fourth Friday evenings and join us in Mayors Walk Park for Music in the Park.



- In October, learn more about Locust Grove's ghosts, friends and acquaintances at Storytelling in the Park. Across from the Park, Scarecrow Village appears. Businesses, families and civic groups display scarecrows throughout the month. A Haunted House also appears on the grounds of City Hall at Halloween.
- Christmas officially begins in Locust Grove with the Lighting of the Tree on Thanksgiving night. Santa makes an appearance and returns again in December for Christmas Downtown hosted by the merchants.
 Children and adults alike will delight in a parade, entertainment, food, train rides, craft activities, and of course, plenty of shopping.
