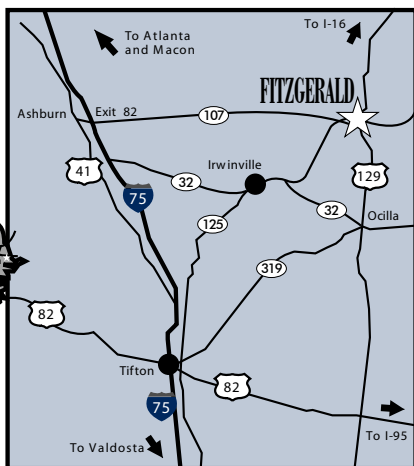
Yanks and Rebs resting together...
