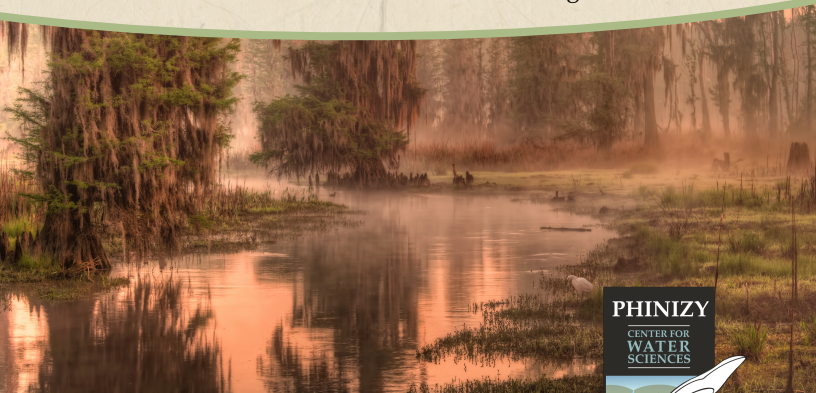


Discover the Natural Beauty of Phinizy Swamp Nature Park

Large covered picnic pavilion, picnic tables, grills &

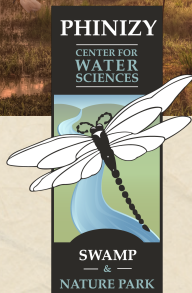

DIRECTIONS:

Off I-520 / Bobby Jones Expressway, go to exit 10, Doug Bernard Parkway / Augusta Regional Airport. If traveling East, turn right off ramp, if West turn left. After approximately 1 mile turn left onto Lock and Dam Road. Travel under 1/2 mile until you see the Phinizy Swamp Nature Park entrance sign. The park is on your left.

PARKING:

Ample free parking is available at the Nature Park's main entrance parking lot. Handicap parking is also available in the main campus lot.

ACCESSIBILITY:

We have a number of boardwalks within the park. None of the trails are paved; many are accessible with bikes, strollers or wheelchairs. Some trails are grass or dirt-covered, while others are gravel or traverse heavily wooded areas.

FACILITIES:

Public restrooms are on site. There are also bike racks, picnic tables and grills available. The Visitor Center and Swamp Shop are open on Saturday and Sunday. Indoor and outdoor rental space available.

POLICIES:

Alcoholic beverages, smoking, hunting, and fishing are prohibited. Leashed pets are permitted. For the benefit of all park visitors we ask that you PLEASE clean up after your pets.
