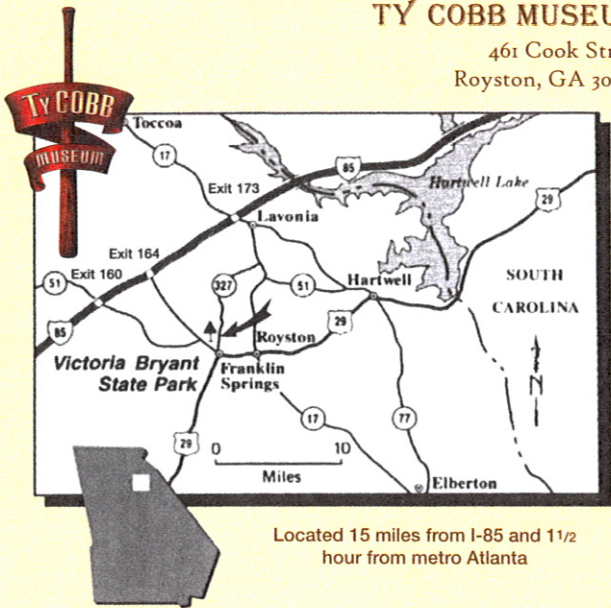


THE GREATNESS OF COBB

- Scored a major-league record 2,245 runs
- American League career hit leader with 4,191
- Stole 894 bases, including 55 thefts of home plate
